



How can I choose to allow pop-ups from a specific website?

By default, Internet Explorer displays pop-ups that appear as a result of you clicking a link or button. Pop-up Blocker blocks pop-ups that are displayed automatically (without you clicking a link or button). If you want to allow a specific website to display automatic pop-ups, follow these steps:

1. Open Internet Explorer by clicking the **Start** button , and then clicking **Internet Explorer**.
2. Click the **Tools** button, click **Pop-up Blocker**, and then click **Pop-up Blocker Settings**.
3. In the **Address of website to allow** box, type the address (or URL) of the website you want to see pop-ups from, and then click **Add**.
4. Repeat step 3 for every website you want to allow pop-ups from. When you are finished adding websites, click **Close**.

How do I turn Pop-up Blocker on or off?

Pop-up Blocker is turned on in Internet Explorer by default. To turn it off or to turn it on again if you've already turned it off, follow these steps:

1. Open Internet Explorer by clicking the **Start** button , and then clicking **Internet Explorer**.
2. Click the **Tools** button, and then click **Pop-up Blocker**.
3. Do one of the following:
 - To turn off Pop-up Blocker, click **Turn Off Pop-up Blocker**.
 - To turn on Pop-up Blocker, click **Turn On Pop-up Blocker**.
