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PREFACE

When arrangements were being finalised to release Paper 1 of 1971, it was not contemplated to bring out a Supplement in about a month's time in view of the fact that all the seven Tables prescribed by the Registrar-General, India, were being included in the initial Paper. However, it was later on decided to bring out a Supplement in view of the demand for tahsil-wise figures for the rural sector and change in population figures of certain towns communicated by the district authorities after release of Paper 1. The latter eventuality has resulted in a marginal change of 0.05 per cent in the composition of urban population to total population.

2. To meet the demand of tahsil-wise figures, Table VIII has been prepared and in view of changes in the composition and break-up of urban population, Table IV published in Paper 1 has been reproduced after making necessary corrections, while Table V has been recast with necessary corrections to give some additional information. Table IX has been included to give break-up of workers into rural and urban sectors, category-wise, for each district. Table X has been prepared to give an idea about the proportion of households to houses and average size of a household.

3. An effort has been made to make the contents of this Supplement as little repetitive as possible. All the same, figures in Table IV in respect of Chhatarpur, Sehore, Sagar, Bilaspur and Raipur districts and in Table V in respect of Burhanpur (Class I), Mhow Cantonment and Shivpuri (Class II) and Hoshangabad and Narsimhapur (Class III), towns will have to be read alongwith figures given in Paper 1 because of changes that have occurred in respect of growth-rate and sex-ratio. In fact, difference in respect of Burhanpur city is considerable. Necessary explanations for the variations in Tables IV and V have been given at the appropriate places while discussing the data presented in this supplement under the caption "Analysis of Results".

4. Four new maps and one chart have been included to make the figures and analysis more meaningful and easily understandable.

5. I wish to place on record my gratitude to Shri A. Chandra Sekhar, Registrar-General, India, for having acceded to my request to bring out this Supplement, to Shri B. G. Joshi, Controller, Government Central Press, and his team for having agreed to print the Supplement and completing the job expeditiously and to the members of my staff associated with Paper 1 and this Supplement (see Appendix) for the pains taken in compilation of the data and preparation of maps and charts, thereby assisting me in making the initial Paper and this Supplement as comprehensive as possible within the time available.

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ANALYSIS OF RESULTS

In Paper I the provisional population figures of the State as revealed by the 1971 Census, which stand at 41,650,684 on the sunrise of April 1, were discussed from the point of view of size and dispersal of population, growth-rate, density of population, sex-ratio, literacy, rural-urban dispersal, growth of cities and towns and work-participation rate. In this Supplement, a passing reference is being made regarding rural-urban dispersal and growth of cities and towns in order to explain Table IV, which has been published again after necessary corrections, and Table V which, apart from some corrections, carries additional information also. Further, a detailed discussion has been attempted, of course on the basis of provisional figures, of varying growth-rates of tahsils of the State, growth of literacy in the rural and urban sectors, the ratio of workers in different categories to total population and total workers in the rural and urban areas, the average size of households in the rural and urban sectors and rural-urban sex-ratio.

RURAL-URBAN DISPERSAL :

2. Although figures of urban population of Chhatarpur, Sehore, Bilaspur, Raipur and Sagar districts have undergone a change with consequential effect on the rural population, the preliminary study regarding growth-rates of these districts, except Chhatarpur, does not undergo any major change. In respect of Chhatarpur, it was stated that it has shown a very low growth-rate in the urban sector. The position is not all that dismal and on the basis of revised provisional figures of urban population in this district, the growth-rate works out to 42.11 per cent as against the State average of 46.31 per cent.

3. Indore, Ujjain and Jabalpur districts were stated to have recorded a high growth-rate in the rural sector. This was an unfortunate slip; actually the growth-rates in these districts in the rural sector are only slightly above or below the State average of 25.72 per cent.

4. The net effect of marginal changes in the rural urban dispersal of the population is that the growth-rate for the urban sector comes down from 46.85 per cent to 46.31 per cent and that of the rural sector goes up from 24.75 per cent to 25.72 per cent.

GROWTH OF CITIES AND TOWNS :

5. The break-up of 248 towns into the six classes given in Table V of Paper I has undergone a slight change. As against 36 towns indicated in Class III, there are actually 39 towns. Bhatapara, Dabra and Basoda could not find a place in this category earlier as the urban outgrowth figures were inadvertently not added to that of the main towns. Consequently Classes IV to VI now have 181 towns as against 184.

6. In Class I, i.e., towns having a population of more than one lac (termed as cities), the only correction is in respect of Burhanpur. Initially also there was a doubt about the reported growth-rate of 83.75 per cent and subsequent communication only confirmed it. The provisional population of the city is 1.05 lacs and not 1.50 lacs. The growth-rate works out to 28.33 per cent only. The entire reduction in the total population of Class I towns is accounted for by Burhanpur.

7. In the initial Table V, no details of towns falling in Classes IV to VI were given. Full break-up with more information has now been given and it shows that there are 74 towns in Class IV, 95 in Class V and only 12 in Class VI.

8. The growth-rate of towns in different size classes reveals an interesting phenomena. Eleven towns of Class I accounting for 17 towns (on the basis of concept of urban agglomeration) have a total population of 30.75 lacs which is 45.42 per cent of the total urban population. Class II towns, which are also eleven in number, account for a further 9.91 per cent of the urban population. Towns of Class I and Class II only have recorded a higher proportion to total urban population than what it was

in 1961. Very small towns are few in the State, their number being 12 only accounting for 0.69 per cent of the total urban population. The inset Table given below explains the relative proportions and growth-rates of different classes of towns :—

GROWTH OF RURAL AREAS :

9. The growth-rate of rural areas of the State has gone up from 20.95 per cent to 25.72 per cent. Out of a total of 190 tahsils, 109 tahsils have recorded a growth-rate higher than the State average.

10. Narainpur tahsil (77.94%) and Raipur tahsil (60.35%) are first and second from the top. The reasons for these two tahsils recording a very high growth-rate are not far to seek. The displaced persons from East Pakistan have been settled in very large numbers, in transit camps at Mana and Kurud in Raipur tahsil and on a permanent basis in the Dandakaranya Project area in Narainpur tahsil.

11. Pichhore tahsil (9.71%) and Janjgir tahsil (4.19%) have recorded very low growth-rates. Manendragarh tahsil (—5.33%) is the only rural area of the State which has returned a negative growth-rate. The explanation for this perhaps lies in the fact that two new towns, viz., Kurasia and South Jhagrakhand Colliery, were recognised in this tahsil as a result of which the urban population in this tahsil has returned a growth-rate of 130.66 per cent.

12. It is interesting to note that all the tahsils of Satna, Sidhi, Dhar, Vidisha and Damch districts have returned a growth-rate higher than the State average of 25.72 per cent.

13. The biggest tahsil in the State is Bilaspur with a population of 677,850 followed by Baloda Bazar which has a population of 566,554. The smallest tahsil is Bharatpur which has only 37,204 inhabitants. As a matter of fact, Bilaspur tahsil and Bharatpur tahsil retain their 1961 positions at the top and bottom in the matter of tahsils by population size, respectively.

14. Bilaspur district which had the highest rural population in 1961 has been displaced from the top and its place has been occupied by Raipur district which has a rural population of 2,286,069. Datia continues to be at the bottom with 217,882.

RURAL URBAN LITERACY

15. An analysis of district-wise growth of literacy in the past decade was made in Paper 1. Figures of literacy rate in the rural and urban sectors of the State, district-wise, have now been worked out. In respect of towns, the information has been incorporated in the revised Table V and for the rural areas, Table VIII has been prepared which includes this information.

16. The rural and urban literacy percentages in 1961 were 12.73 and 43.52, respectively. The corresponding figures for 1971 work out to 16.76 per cent and 49.76 per cent, respectively. The decennial literacy growth-rates for the rural and urban sectors thus work out to 31.66 per cent and 14.34 per cent, respectively, which cannot be considered as encouraging by any yardstick.

17. In all the figures worked out above, the age-group 0-4 years stands included. The percentages for 1961 show an increase of 2.52 in the rural sector and 7.85 in the urban sector if the age-group 0-4 years is excluded. Similar increase, it is anticipated, would be reflected in the 1971 literacy percentages also when the age-group 0-4 years is excluded on completion of detailed tabulation of all the individual slips, age-group-wise.

18. In 1961, the male and female literacy percentages in the rural sector (inclusive of age-group 0-4 years) were 21.81 and 3.36, respectively. The corresponding figures for 1971 are 27.06 per cent and 6.00 per cent, respectively. In the urban sector, in 1961 the male and female literacy percentages were 56.51 and 28.35, respectively. The provisional population figures of 1971 show an increase, taking the percentages to 60.78 and 37.08, respectively. From the above figures, it is quite obvious that the State owes its backwardness in the field of literacy to the very low percentage of literacy among females, especially in the rural sector. An all-out effort for raising the percentage of literacy among females is indicated.

19. In the rural sector, the literacy rate is highest in Durg tahsil (26.83%), followed by Indore tahsil (26.64%) and Narsimhapur tahsil (26.52%). At the bottom is Konta tahsil of Bastar district (2.62%). The reason for Durg tahsil having the highest rate of literacy perhaps lies in the fact that Nandini, from where lime-stone is supplied to the Bhilai Steel Plant, and Kumhari, which has half-a-dozen medium scale industries, are included in it. Konta tahsil is a backward tract of the predominantly tribal district of Bastar. If the districts on the whole are considered, then Narsimhapur district (25.41%) is at the top; at the tail end is Jhabua (5.02%).

20. Urban literacy rate is highest in Pachmarhi Cantonment (65.23%) whereas at the bottom is Khajuraho town (24.70%). Out of 248 towns in the State, 70 towns have a literacy rate higher than the State average of 49.76 per cent. The inset Table given below shows the names of towns, class-wise, having the highest and lowest literacy rate. The average literacy rate of each size class has been indicated within brackets to give an idea about the relative position of the towns having the highest and lowest literacy rate in comparison to the average literacy rate of a particular size class :—

WORK PARTICIPATION RATE :

21. The district-wise work participation rate was discussed in Paper 1. In Table IX, the rural urban break-up of workers in different categories has been given.

22. The percentage of workers to total population in the State is 37.30. The percentage of the rural sector works out to 39.08 while that of the urban sector is lower at 28.17. The percentages of male and female workers comes to 53.83 and 19.77, respectively. It is interesting to note that percentages of rural workers, both male and female, are higher than the State average while that of urban workers are lower than the State average. Greater participation in work by females in the countryside and relatively greater unemployment in the urban areas perhaps explains this phenomena.

23. Satna, Shahdol, Sidhi, Chhindwara, Balaghat, Bilaspur, Durg and Raipur districts have recorded a work participation rate higher than the State average, both in rural as well as urban sectors. In Mandasaur, Shajapur, Betul, Mandla and Seoni

districts, the work participation rate in the rural sector only as well as for total district is higher than the State average. As against this, Raigarh and Bastar districts have a higher work participation rate in the urban sector only, as also for total district. The remaining 28 districts have work participation rate below the State average in all respects, or in total district plus either the rural sector or the urban sector. The inset Table given below shows the position of districts on the basis of work participation rates :—

24. A perusal of the above Table would reveal that the work participation rate is below the State average in the north-western districts of the State which are contiguous. The only exceptions are Mandsaur, Shajapur and Satna districts.

25. The work-participation rate of male workers is above the State average, total district as well as rural and urban, in Shivpuri, Chhatarpur, Shahdol, Sidhi, Balaghat, Bilaspur, Raigarh, Surguja, Durg and Bastar districts. Male workers in Tikamgarh, Panna, Mandsaur, Shajapur, Rajgarh, Vidisha, Betul, Mandla, Chhindwara and Seoni districts have a work-participation rate higher than the State average in total district and rural sector only. Raipur district has a work-participation rate higher than the State average in total district and urban sector only. The remaining districts, are below the State average in all respects, or in total district plus either the rural sector or urban sector.

26. In the rural sector, the highest work-participation rate for males is recorded in Surguja district (60.63%). At the bottom is Jabalpur district (50.23%). In the Urban sector, Bastar district (53.43%) is at the top, perhaps due to low urban population and employment opportunities that became available in the wake of establishment of Bailadilla Iron Ore Project. At the bottom is Narsimhapur district (42.10%).

27. As regards female workers, the work-participation rate is above the State average in Satna, Rewa, Sidhi, Mandsaur, Betul, Mandla, Chhindwara, Balaghat, Bilaspur, Durg and Raipur districts in all respects, i. e., total district as well as rural and urban sectors. In Shajapur district, the work-participation rate for total district and urban sector only is above the State average, whereas Seoni district has a work-participation rate above the State average in total district and rural sector only. The remaining districts are below the State average either in all respects, or in total district plus rural or urban sector.

28. The highest work-participation rate for females in the rural sector is recorded in Durg district (43.64%). At the end is Bhind (2.47%). In the urban sector, the highest work-participation rate is in Balaghat (13.91%), while Bhind district is again at the bottom (2.55%).

SIZE OF HOUSEHOLDS

29. Table X gives the number of occupied houses and households in the State in the urban and rural areas, respectively. In the Census, the definition of a household is a building or a part of a building having a separate entrance. As regards a household, the definition envisages only a common kitchen irrespective of relationship. In other words, what is meant by a household is not synonymous with family.

30. A more accurate, if not realistic, analysis of living conditions would be possible only after the data about type of structures, number of living rooms and per capita room availability collected in the Houselist, which was canvassed in April-May, 1970, is tabulated. However, a rough approximation is available by way of number of households per 100 occupied houses. The State average has gone up from 106.17 in 1961 to 114.63 in 1971. The increase in the rural sector is from 104.68 to 111.89 and in the urban sector from 115.55 to 130.15. The inset Table given below shows the position of districts on the basis of proportion of households to occupied residential houses :—

31. Some indication of congestion in living accommodation can be had from the proportion of households to houses. It can be inferred that where the proportion is higher there is relatively more congestion.

32. In the rural sector the proportion is highest in Raisen district (122.63); the lowest proportion is in Shivpuri district (100.97). In the urban sector, Indore district has the highest proportion (212.36); the district with the lowest proportion is Damoh (101.30).

33. The average size of a household has gone up in the State from 4.89 in 1961 to 5.40. The increase in the rural sector is from 4.93 to 5.45 and in the urban sector from 4.69 to 5.15. The district-wise position is as given in the inset Table below :-

34. The largest size of a household is recorded in Khargone district (6.57) in the rural sector. The smallest size of a household is in Shahdol district (4.92). In the urban sector, the largest size of household is in Khandwa district (6.03); the smallest size of household is in Bastar district (3.69).

RURAL URBAN SEX-RATIO

35. The sex-ratio by districts was discussed in Paper 1. In Tables V and VIII the urban rural sex-ratio, unit-wise, has been given.

36. The State sex-ratio for the rural areas works out to 958, whereas it is only 869 for the urban areas. Movement of males from the rural areas to the urban areas, both for service as well as in search of employment, easily explains this phenomena.

37. The highest sex-ratio in the rural areas is in Kanker tahsil where there are 1,050 females per 1,000 males. The lowest ratio of 796 has been recorded in Morena tahsil. Out of 190 tahsils, the sex-ratio is above the State average in 75 tahsils.

38. In the urban areas, the highest and the lowest sex-ratio, class-wise, is as per the inset Table given below.

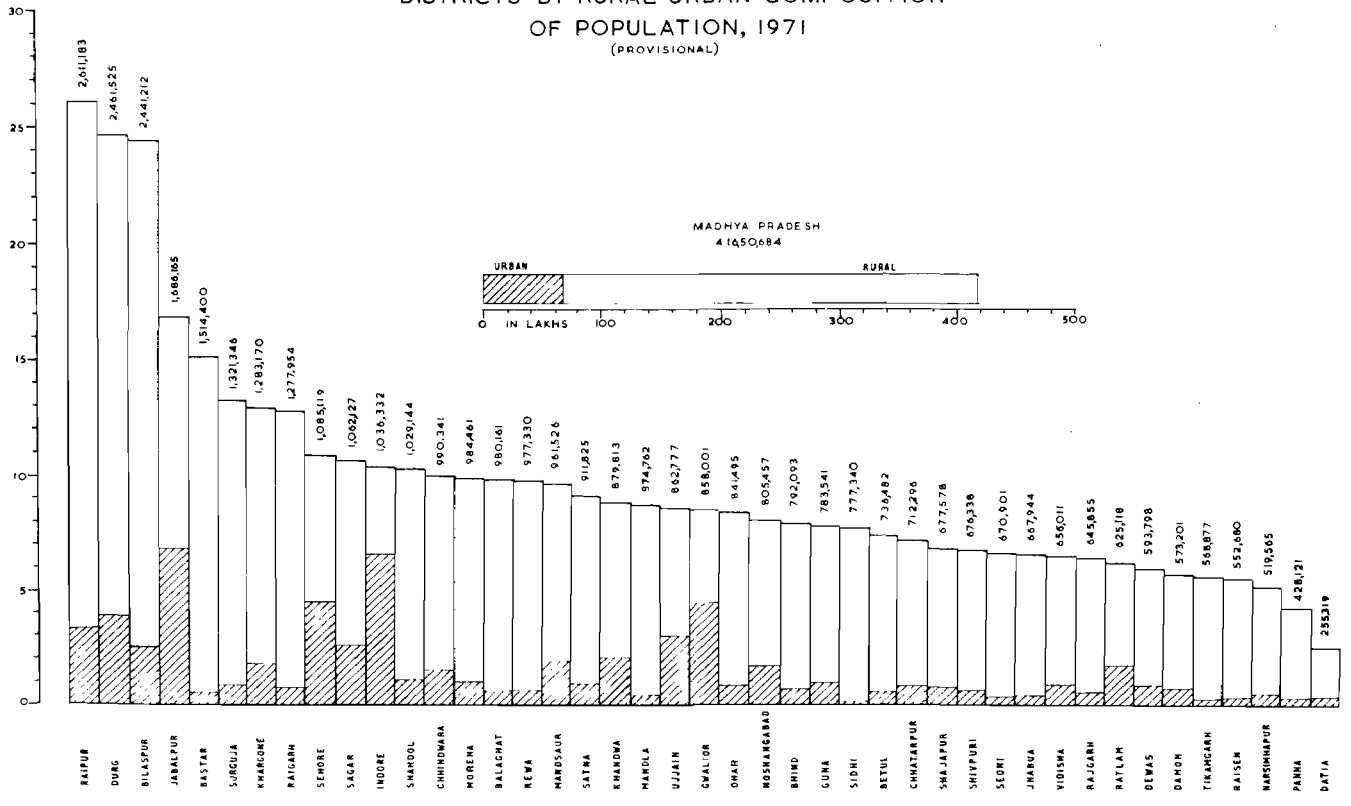

DISTRICTS BY RURAL-URBAN COMPOSITION OF POPULATION, 1971 (PROVISIONAL)

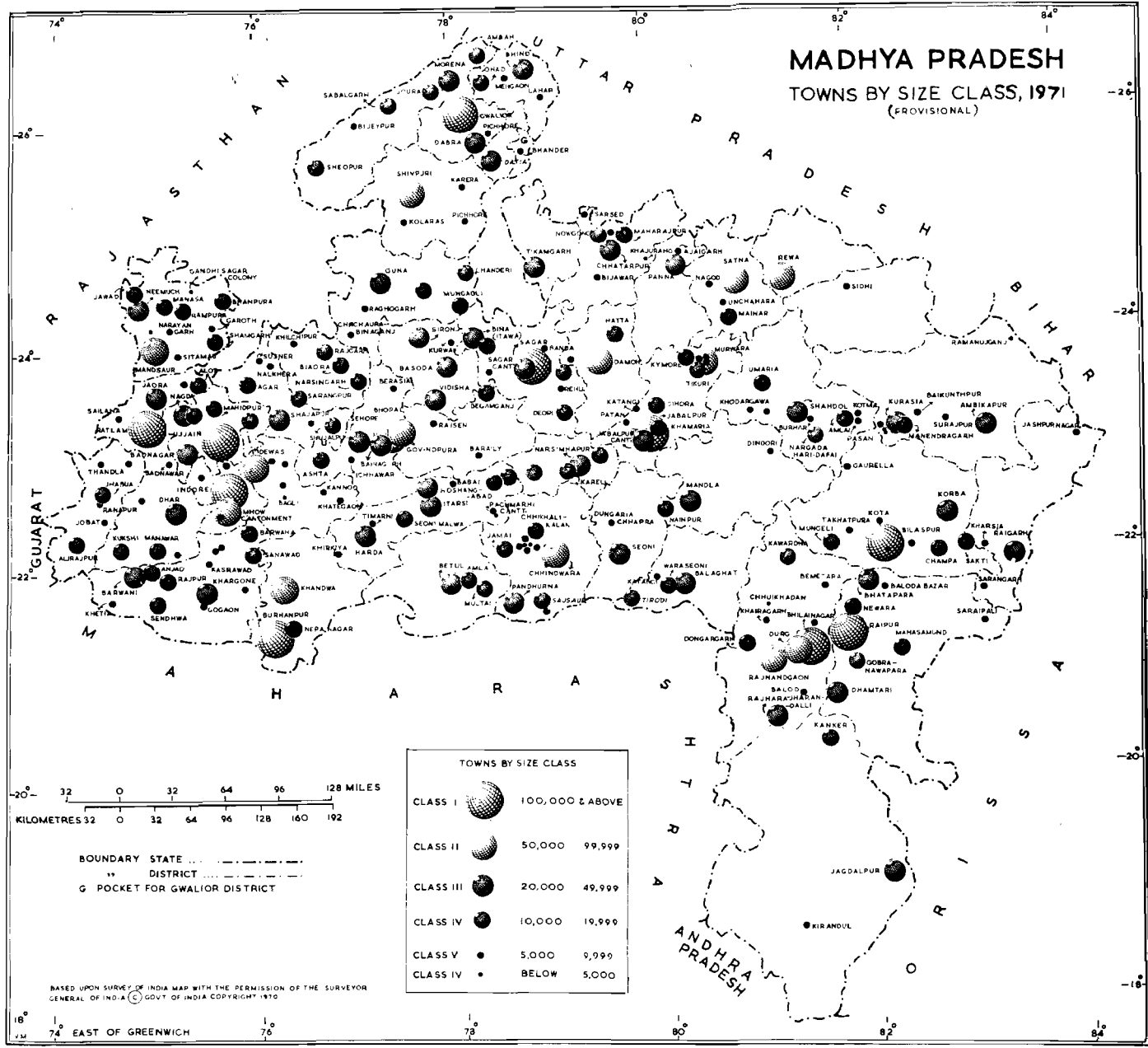

TOWNS BY SIZE CLASS, 1971

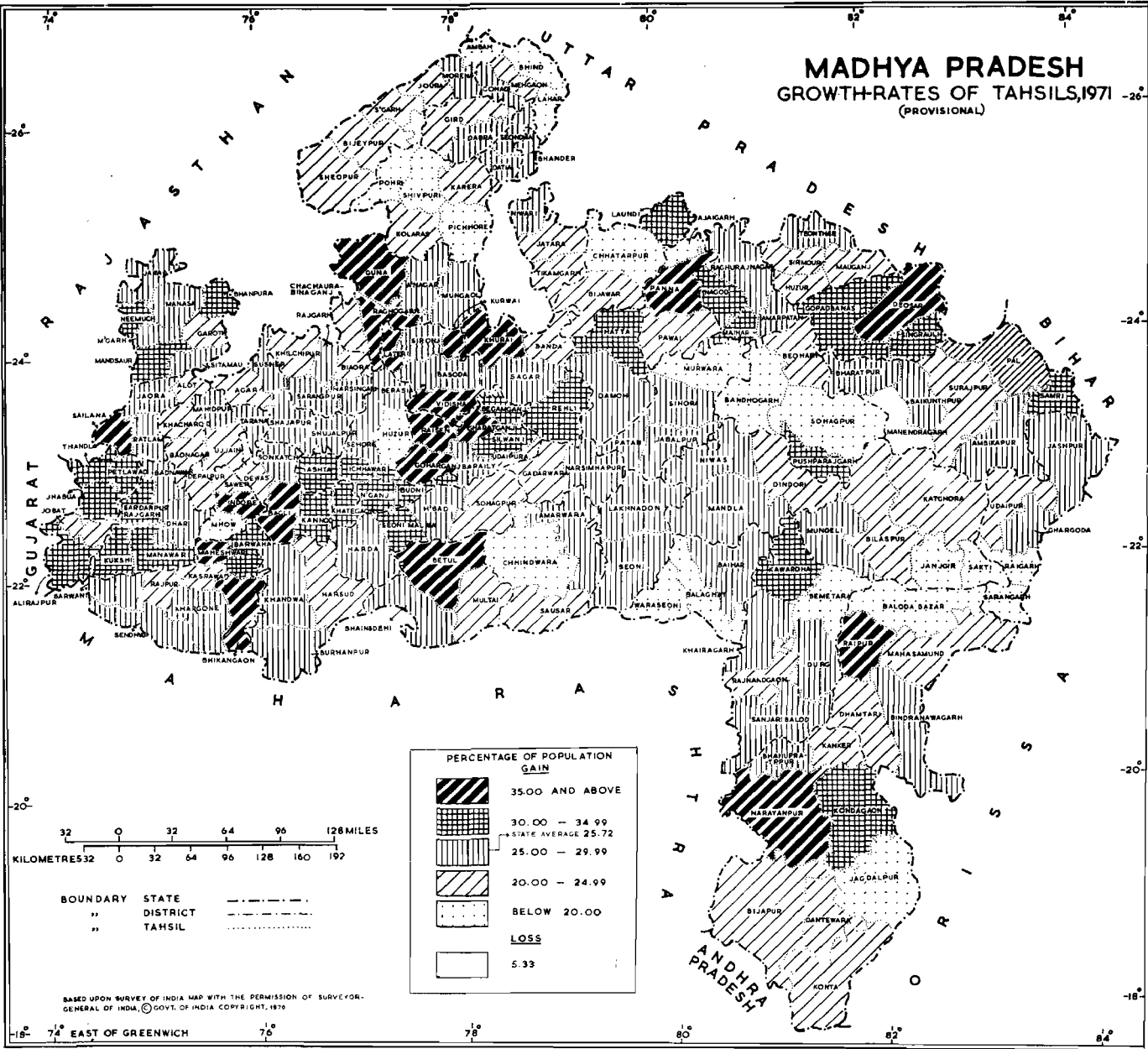

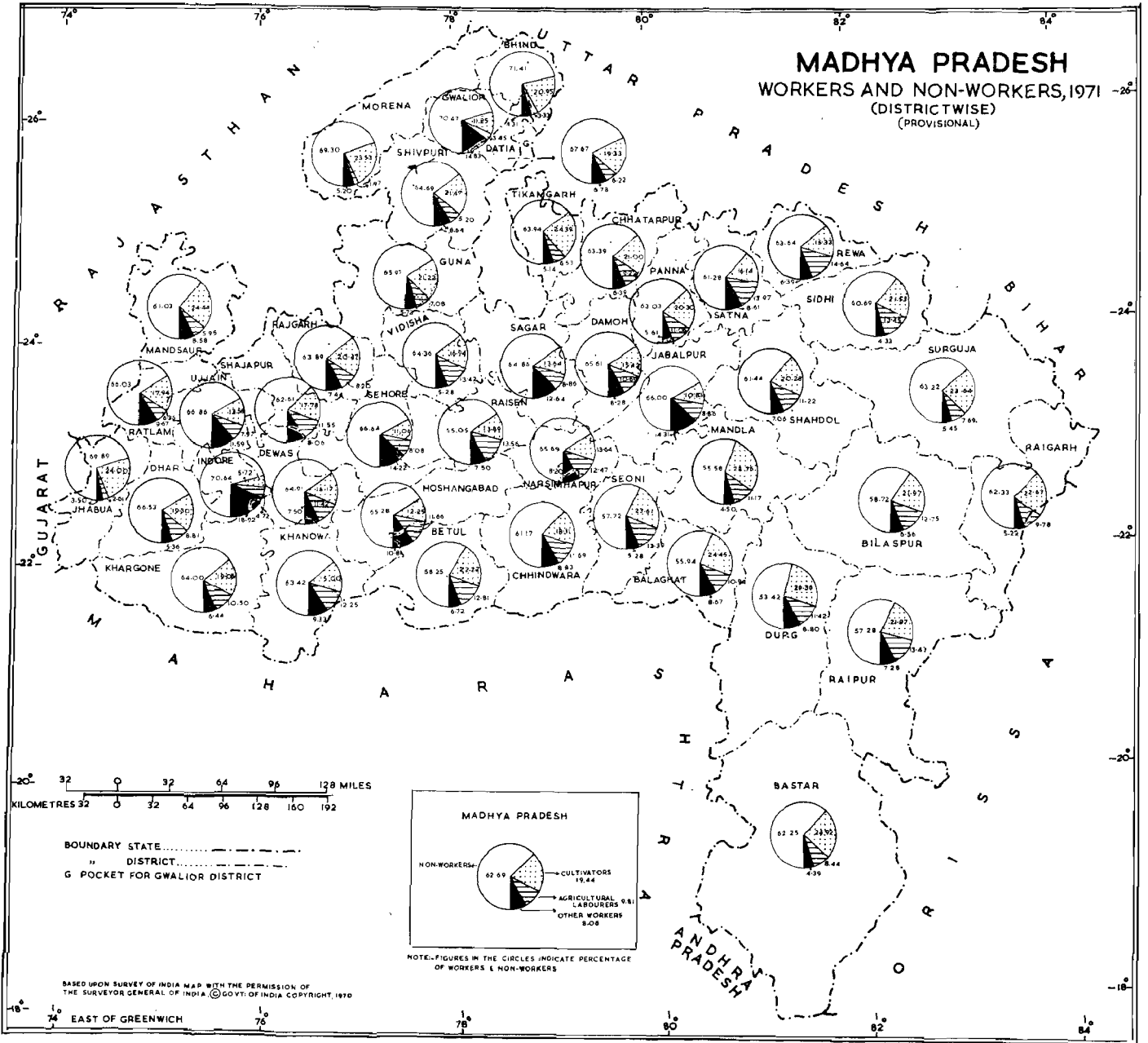
