PREFACE

OUR READERS may recall that soon after the 1971 Census was taken, we had issued a paper by the middle of April, 1971 presenting some of the basic particulars about our people in Rajasthan. We released the figures, even though they were only crude totals having been built up through a rapid relay of counts from a massive fleet of census workers spread throughout the length and breadth of the State. Four months later, by the middle of August, we again published a supplement to the said paper seeking to release some details and the additional information which became available to us by that time. The tabulation of census data is a gruelling and a time consuming process, and although quite a long time has passed since we took the Census, the tabulation for it still goes on. Our anxiety to satisfy the demands of our readers, however, has again impelled us to bring out whatever information we have been able to cull out from the massive information now being processed. The figures used in this book have been built as a consequence of the regular tabulation and are, therefore, final.

A number of simple tables have been provided in this pocket book which give an idea about some of the demographic aspects of the State as a whole and at the district, tehsil and town levels. A couple of tables on India and various states have also been provided to assist the reader in having an all India comparative picture. These tables are preceded by a note which introduces the subject matter of this pocket book and gives the necessary background material.

The bringing out of this booklet on the eve of the thirteenth Senior Officers Conference, is owed entirely to the kind encouragement and guidance provided by Shri S. L. Khurana, Chief Secretary to the Government of Rajasthan.

All credit for compiling this booklet and for seeing it through the press goes to Dr. U. B. Mathur, Deputy Director, Shri S. R. Luhadia, Assistant Director and other colleagues, listed overleaf, in this Directorate. Shri Patni of the Jubilee Block Works took special pains to ensure neat and timely printing.

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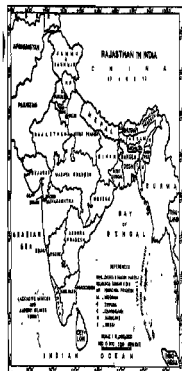
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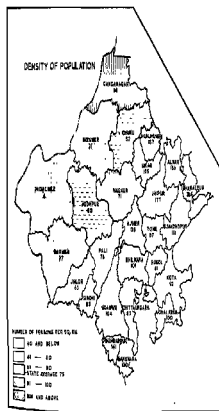

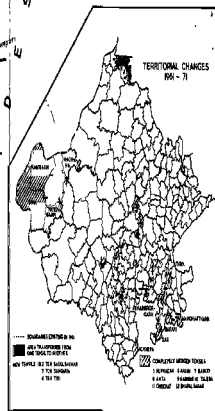

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INTRODUCTORY NOTE

In this booklet, which is a sort of a Fact Book on population of Rajasthan, several small tables have been presented. They have been appropriately grouped : a batch of ten opening tables relates to the State as a whole, a set of thirty-two tables which follow refers to the districts of the State, and finally a group of seven tables presents a comparative picture of Rajasthan alongwith some demographic characteristics of other states. Towards the end, an appendix shows the population in the various tehsils and towns by sex and literacy and population of scheduled castes and scheduled tribes. A set of four maps which illustrate this booklet shows the growth of population, sex ratio, literacy and distribution of working population by primary, secondary & tertiary sectors. Of the State tables, the first three deal with the growth of population, the sex ratio, variation, the rural and urban composition of population and the progress of literacy in Rajasthan from decade to decade during the period 1901-1971. A perusal of these tables takes us to the following conclusions :—

- 1. We have been growing rather fast and during the last two decades we have multiplied very rapidly. Our population has almost doubled since 1941.**
- 2. If the rate of growth is allowed to remain unchanged, it would double again over the next 30 years only to reach over 50 millions at the turn of the century.**
- 3. There have been erratic changes in the sex ratio in the past. There are now 911 females to every 1000 males. The sex ratio in the urban areas of Rajasthan, however, is rather low (875).**
- 4. The number of literates have continuously been rising in Rajasthan. The literacy rate too has risen from 3 to 19 per cent**

during the last seventy years. Most of the progress, however, has been made during the last two decades. The literacy among the male population is about 29 per cent but the female literacy is still distressingly low (8 per cent).

The fourth table shows the distribution of population by religious communities. The data has been presented from 1941 onwards. The following points emerge :—

1. The Hindus form the most predominant religious community of the State and their proportionate strength in the population has throughout been around 90 per cent.
2. The second largest community is that of Muslims. The proportionate strength has fallen ever since the partition of the country which resulted in the large in-migration of Hindus and some out-migration of Muslims in the State. They now form about 7 per cent of the population of the State.
3. The Jains, the Sikhs, the Christians and the Buddhists are the remaining religious minorities and together make up a little over 3 per cent of the total population, the last two communities contributing very low proportions.

The fifth table relates to the speakers of principal languages and dialects as recorded in the censuses of 1961 and 1971. Some interesting observations can be made :—

1. Hindi has emerged as the most predominant language of the State, being spoken by over 60 per cent of our population.
2. Hindi seems to have claimed large levies from other dialects. The corresponding figure for this language in 1961 was only 3.23. A very large number of people had then recorded their language as Khariboli and it appears that all of them as well as many of those speakers who used to speak other dialects such

as Dhundhari, Marwari, Mewari and Wagdi have now switched over to Hindi.

The sixth and seventh tables detail certain particulars about the scheduled castes and the scheduled tribes of Rajasthan. A glance at them indicates the following :—

1. About 16 per cent of our population belongs to the scheduled castes. Their proportions in the urban areas of the State are, however, lower (13 per cent). Literacy amongst the scheduled castes is as low as around 9 per cent.
2. About 12 per cent of the population belongs to the scheduled tribes. The bulk of the tribes resides in the rural areas and their proportion in the urban areas is only 1.49 per cent. Literacy amongst the scheduled tribes is very low (6.47 per cent).

The eighth table gives the number of villages and towns classified by population. It will be seen that :—

1. 82 per cent of our population resides in 33,305 villages, varying in size from a tiny one having a single soul to one (Rawat Bhata) having as much as over 15,000 population. Nearly half of the rural population resides in small villages having less than 1,000 population.
2. About 18 per cent of our population resides in the 157 urban centres and a large section of such population (42 per cent) lives in towns having population over 1 lakh.

Table ninth shows the age structure of the population. A glance at the table would show that :—

1. About 50 per cent of our population lies in the age-group 15-59, which can be taken as our working force.

2. The remaining 50 per cent of the population lies in the age-groups 0-14 and 60+, which consists of the dependents.

The tenth and the last table in this section relates to workers and non-workers in our population. The working population is divided into several industrial categories. It will be observed :—

1. About 52 per cent of our male population is economically active, while the rest consists of non-workers which includes the students, those engaged in household duties, dependents and infants, retired persons, rentiers and persons of independent means, beggars, vagrants, etc. and inmates of penal, mental and charitable institutions.
2. Of the above mentioned 52 per cent of the male population which is economically active, the largest number (33.90 per cent) of workers belong to the category of cultivators (category I). Other services (category IX) engages the next largest proportion (4.60 per cent). Agricultural labourers (category II) form 3.98 per cent of the workers. About 2.60 per cent belong to the Trade and Commerce (category VII), 1.82 per cent to Manufacturing, Processing, Servicing and repairs of Household Industry (category Va) and 1.81 per cent to Manufacturing, Processing, Servicing and repairs at other than Household Industry (category Vb), 1.27 per cent to Livestock, Forestry, Fishing, Hunting and Plantations, Orchards and allied activities (category III) and 1.17 per cent to Transport, Storage and Communications (category VIII). Construction (category VI) and Mining & Quarrying (category IV) accounts for 0.70 and 0.24 per cent respectively.

Only a little over 8 per cent of our female population is economically active—the rest is primarily engaged in household duties or belong to the other categories of non-workers such as students, dependents and infants, beggars, vagrants etc. The bulk of these women workers, is engaged in agriculture—around 5 per cent as cultivators and about 2 per cent as

agricultural labourers. The remaining are engaged in other activities, such as other services and manufacturing, processing, servicing and repairs both at household industry and at other than household industry. Their participation in other economic activities is rather small.

Of the next group of tables which are presented for the districts, the first shows the ranking of various districts in Rajasthan by population and also by area, as supplied by Survey of India. The next two tables relate to population and the variation in population. Banswara, Nagaur, Kota and Ganganagar districts are amongst those which have recorded high increases in population during the last decade. Tables Fourth and Fifth deal with the rural and urban composition of population and variation of population in rural and urban areas. Bhilwara, Jaisalmer and Kota districts are amongst those which have recorded very high increases in population in their urban areas. Sex ratio is the subject matter of the sixth table. The highest sex ratio is seen in the tribal district of Dungarpur where there are as many as 1,015 females for every 1,000 males. The lowest sex ratio is found in Jaisalmer (810). Sex ratios are usually lower in urban areas of the districts as compared to their rural areas but in case of urban areas of Jaisalmer district it is unusually low (739). The table which follows shows the area of districts according to the Survey of India and presents the density of population. With the growth of population, density has been increasing from decade to decade. District Bharatpur has the highest density of population followed by Jaipur and Alwar districts.

A batch of three tables—eighth, ninth and tenth shows the progress of literacy in districts in their total, rural and urban areas. It will be observed that there has been an alround progress in literacy both amongst males and females and both in rural and urban areas. Two tables, which then follow, give the proportionate strength and population of the religious communities. While the Hindus are the predominant community in all districts, their proportion to the total population vary from 75 per cent in Jaisalmer to over 95 per cent in Dungarpur district. Muslims, Jains and Sikhs are the other important religious communities. While Muslims are the second largest community in twenty-two districts, notably in Jaisalmer-

(about 24 per cent), Barmer (about 12 per cent), and Bikaner (about 11 per cent), the Jains are the second largest in Jalor, Sirohi and Udaipur districts (in Jalor they form a little more than 5 per cent of population). The Sikhs have the second place in Ganganagar district where they contribute a little over 19 per cent of the population. The Christians, though they are very few in numbers, are there almost in all the districts, while, the Buddhists are even conspicuous by their absence in five districts.

The thirteenth table deals with the speakers of principal languages and dialects in the districts. It will be seen that Hindi is the most predominant language in all districts except in eleven districts namely Pali, Nagaur, Jalor, Jodhpur, Barmer, Sirohi, Churu, Bikaner and Jaisalmer where Marwari is the most popular and in Banswara and Dungarpur districts where Bagri-Rajasthani is spoken by most people.

Six tables then follow, three each about the proportionate strength of the population of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in total, rural and urban areas. Scheduled Castes are found in all the districts in strength ranging from 12 to 24 per cent of the districts total population except in districts Udaipur, Dungarpur and Banswara where their proportionate strength ranges only between 4 to 8 per cent. Total literacy rates in all districts are rather low except in district Ajmer (19 per cent). Rates in urban areas are even better. The Scheduled Tribes are mostly concentrated in districts Banswara and Dungarpur where their proportionate strength to total population is 73 and 64 per cent respectively. In Udaipur district also they form about 34 per cent of the population. Literacy rates are very low in the regions of their concentrations; in Bikaner their literacy is high but their population there itself is very insignificant.

The twentieth table gives the population of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes.

Three tables (tables 21, 22 and 23) which follow give the percentage distribution of population by workers and non-workers for total, rural and urban areas of the districts. We have earlier seen the proportions of male and female workers (52 and 8 per cent respectively) to the male and female population of the State. Taking population as a whole, however, only 31 per cent of our population is economically active primarily. Higher

proportions are observed in thirteen districts headed by district Bhilwara (39 per cent) where the male and female participation rates are as high as 61 per cent and 16 per cent respectively.

A glance at the batch of six tables running from table 24 to 29, which present the percentage distribution of male workers and female workers separately and for the total, rural and urban areas of the districts, would show that out of every one hundred male workers in the State around 75 are engaged in the primary sector, about 9 in the secondary sector and the remaining 16 in the tertiary sector of economic activity. At the district level, however, the ratios for primary sector range widely from 58 in Ajmer to 89 in Banswara district; corresponding data for the female working population shows that out of every one hundred female workers in the State around 88 are engaged in the primary sector, about 5 per cent in the secondary sector and the remaining 7 in the tertiary sector of economic activity. The ratios for primary sector at the district level range from 64 in Jaisalmer to 94 in Nagaur district.

The last three tables in this section, tables, 30, 31 and 32 present information about the number of occupied residential houses, households, their sizes, households in proportion to houses and number of persons per room, separately for total, rural and urban areas. The average size of a household in the State is 5.7 persons and there are 2.55 persons per room.

A group of seven all India tables, are now presented. The opening table in this series shows the growth of population in India, variation, changes in sex-ratio and density from decade to decade. The remaining tables present Rajasthan alongwith other states in India with a view to have a comparative picture about population, growth rate, sex-ratio, density of population, literacy, proportionate strength of scheduled castes and scheduled tribes, and also of various religious communities, and finally, proportions of working and non-working populations and percentage distribution of working population by three sectors of economic activity-primary, secondary and tertiary.

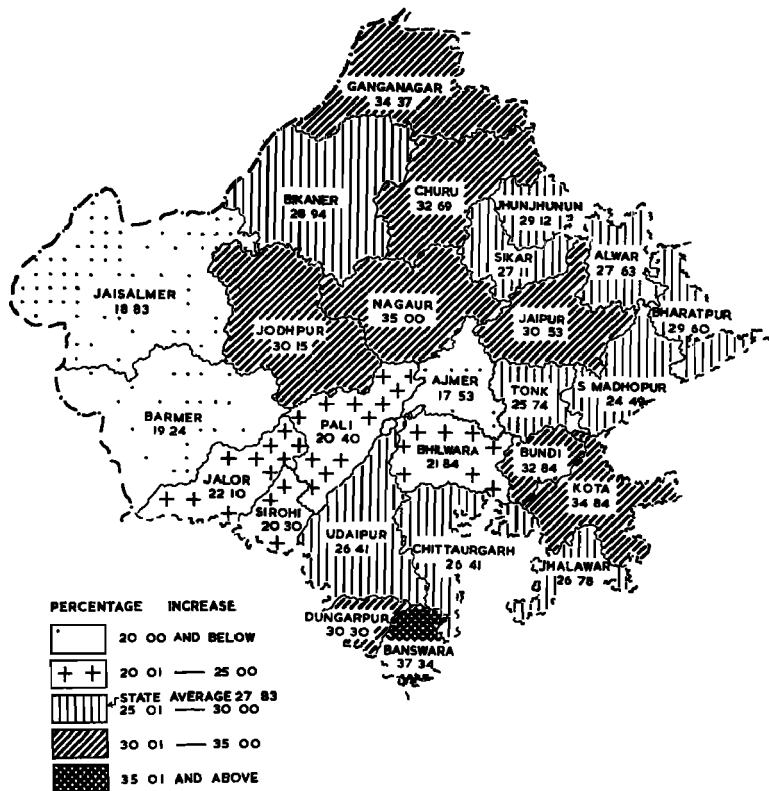

GROWTH OF POPULATION

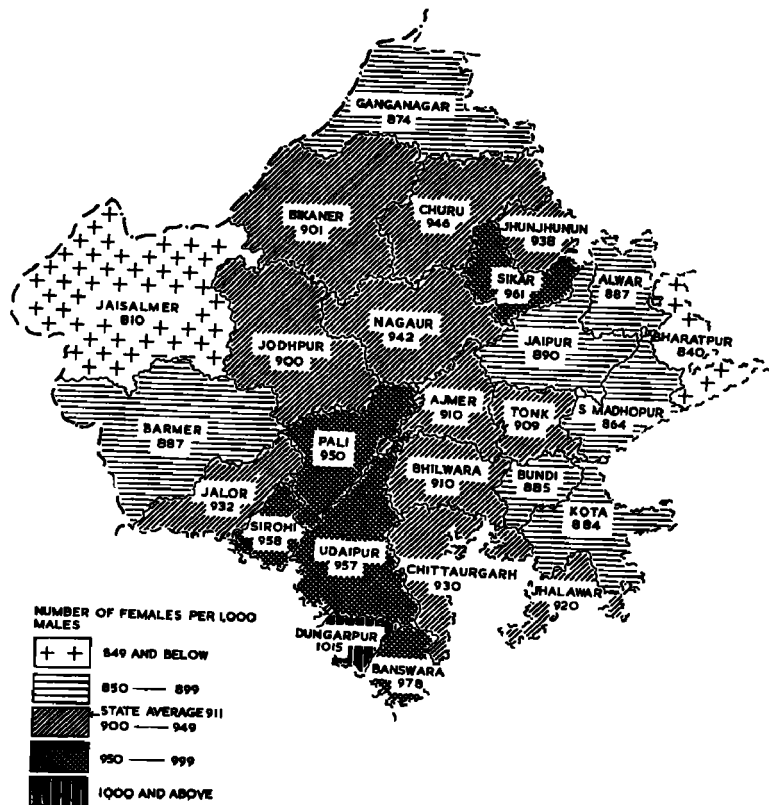

SEX RATIO

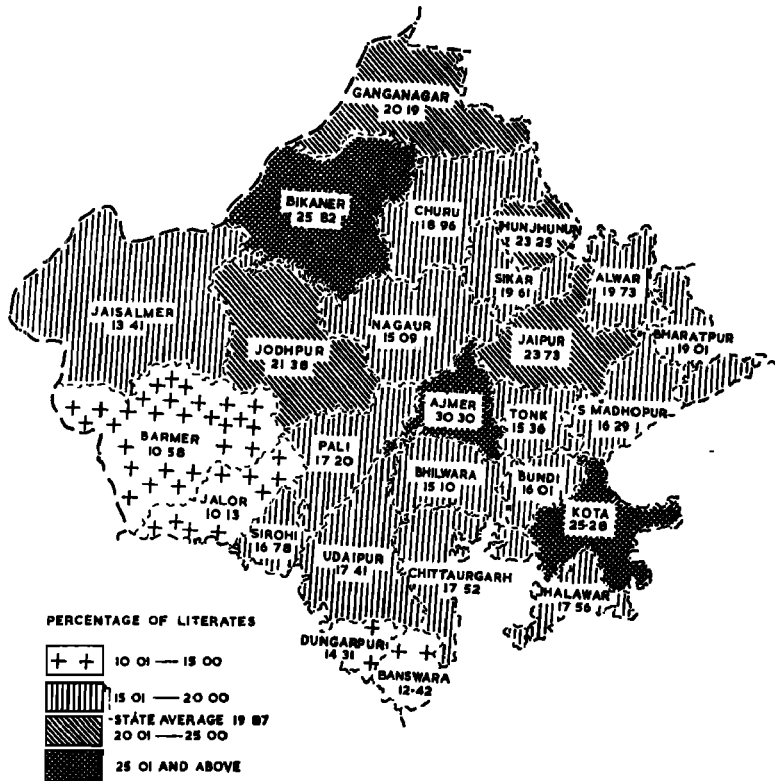

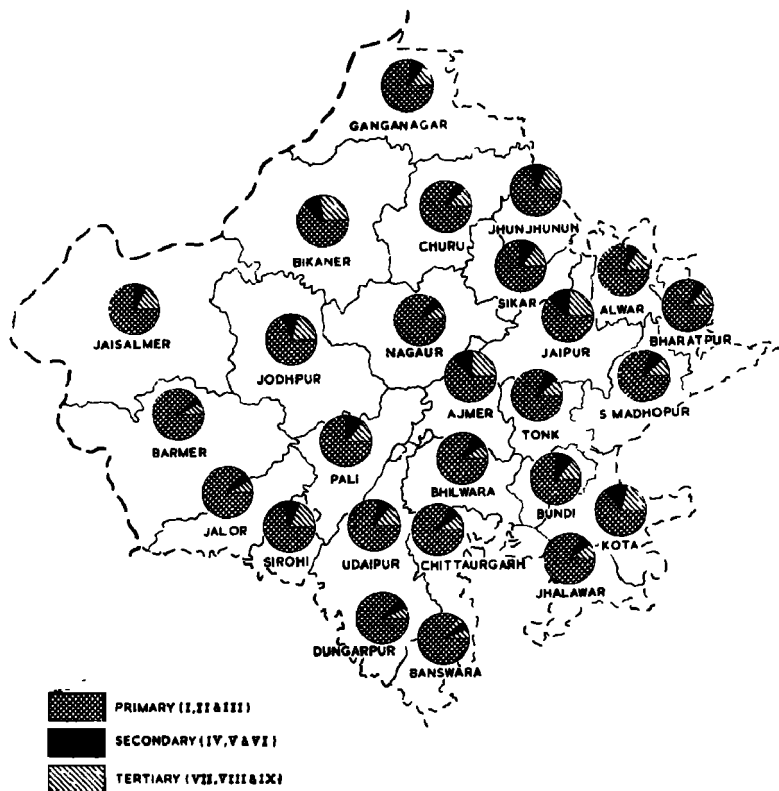
LITERACY
