P R E F A C E.

There have been in all four enumerations of the Ratlam State. The first was taken on 17th February 1881; the second on 26th February 1891, the third on 1st March 1901 and the fourth or the present on 10th March 1911. All these were synchronous with those taken in British India; but in the first two a modified schedule of 8 columns was employed, information being collected on the following points, viz., (1) Number, (2) Name, (3) Religion, (4) Sex, (5) Age, (6) Caste, (7) Birth-place, and (8) Occupation. In 1901 and on the present occasion the British India schedule of 16 columns was exactly applied and the results were incorporated in the Central India Imperial Tables.

As soon as it was decided that a decennial Census should be taken, the preparation of a complete village list for the State was commenced, giving the number and names of villages and hamlets and the Agency available for enumeration. This was compiled and sent to the Central India Agency Office in February 1910 before the appointment of the Census Officer. In March 1910, Mr. Dorabji Fardunji Vakil, B. A., Member of the State Council, who had previous experience, was appointed Census Officer of the State. In April the Census Officer with two selected supervisors attended the training class at Indore and received complete instruction with regard to house-numbering, forming of Census divisions and the actual entries to be made in the Census schedule. The Census Code, the Manual of Instruction for Charge Superintendents and Supervisors and the Enumeration Book Cover containing instructions to Enumerators for filling up the 16 columns of the schedule and typical entries were read and thoroughly explained. On returning to Ratlam the Census Officer opened a class for the training of local officials; while Pandit Ramkishan Joshi was deputed to give theoretical and practical training in the district. This was done most efficiently as the results afterwards proved. The printed instructions in the Code, the Manual and the Cover were so full that no necessity was felt for supplementing them by circulars.

The next step taken was the division of the State into Charges, Circles and Blocks. These numbered respectively 4, 51 and 671. The Head Master of the Darbar High School was appointed Charge Superintendent for the City and the Sadar Tahsildar (Chief Revenue Officer), the Bajna Tahsildar and the Munsarim Jagirdārān were appointed Charge Superintendents in the districts for the Ratlam Tahsil, the Bajna Tahsil and the Jagirs respectively. Subordinate Revenue and Police officials and school masters acted as Supervisors; and junior clerks, school masters, patwaris, senior students and literate shop-keepers worked as Enumerators. All the Charge Superintendents and the Supervisors (except two supervisors in Charge No. 1, the City), and 275 Enumerators were State officials, others being non-officials. Of the latter 10, who were deputed to Bajna, were given wages for 6 days and the usual travelling expenses, it being impossible to procure literate men to work in that hilly district without remuneration. Each stage of the operations was carried on exactly in accordance with the Census Calendar.

Although plague appeared during the preliminary operations there was no difficulty in carrying out the Census Proper except in the village of Dantoria. In this village fresh numbers were given in the plague camps, Blocks were formed and fresh Block Lists were prepared.

The attitude of the people, even the Bhils, was not unfavourable. No opposition was offered even in the areas infected with plague. There was no occasion for a Census Act.

Special arrangements for the despatch of the Provisional Totals were not required, the remotest villages being not more than 36 miles distant from the City. The Enumeration Books and the Summaries for the State as a whole were all received in good time in the Office of the Census Officer. The totals were despatched to the Census Commissioner for India and to the Provincial Superintendent of Census on the 14th March 1911. These figures had been compiled very carefully and the Final Figure, arrived at after abstraction and tabulation, differed by only 58 or 7 in 10,000, which was creditable to the Census Officer and the Darbar.

The State supplied its own staff for abstraction, tabulation and compilation under Supervisor Pandit Ghanshyamji, which worked most excellently throughout.

The accounts have not yet been finally adjusted, as printing is still going on, but the expenditure incurred up to date is Rs. 1,767 which works out to 4·5 pies per head of population.

This is the second time the Darbar has had a separate Census Report.

In conclusion, I would express my indebtedness to Major His Highness Raja Sir Sajjan Singh, K.C.S.I., for the support given me throughout the operations to which the successful results owe so much. I would bring to the notice of His Highness the excellent services again rendered in this connection by Mr. Vakil. He has now co-operated with me in Census and Gazetteer work for over 12 years. His intimate knowledge of the State and the people is of exceptional value in a work of this kind and I cannot too highly praise the industry and zeal with which he performed these duties, which deserve special recognition. To Mr. K. K. Nanavati, M. A., Head Master, I am much indebted for the information he supplied on dialects, which added to the value of my Chapter on that subject in the Central India Provincial Report.

CENSUS REPORT OF THE RATLAM STATE.

I. *General*.—Ratlam is the chief Rajput State in the Malwa Political Charge of the Central India Agency lying between latitude $23^{\circ} 6'$ and $23^{\circ} 33'$ N. and longitude $74^{\circ} 31'$ and $75^{\circ} 17'$ E. It has an area of about 643 square miles and a population of 82,497. This includes the figure for villages held by Sarwan and Shivgarh which are unguaranteed. As, however, these estates comprise guaranteed villages held from other Darbars, they have, for the convenience of the census only, been shewn under the head of "Guaranteed Estates" in the State Tables.

The State returned an area of 902 square miles up to the date of the present census, but as the whole State was not then surveyed (the hilly portions being left out) the area hitherto recorded appeared doubtful. Consequently it was traced from the topographical survey sheets, which gave the present figure of 643 square miles, which has been adopted in all the tables.

The territories of the State are inextricably intermingled with those of Sailana and its boundaries are in consequence not very clearly defined; but generally speaking the State touches the territories of Jaora and Partabgarh (in Rajputana) on the north, Gwalior on the east, Dhar and Kushalgarh (in Rajputana) and portions of Indore in the south and Kushalgarh and Banswara (in Rajputana) on the west.

II. *Administrative and Natural Divisions*.—For administrative purposes the State is divided into two Tahsils, viz., Ratlam and Bajna. For census purposes all the Jagirs in the State were formed into a separate charge and dealt with as an independent unit.

The whole State lies on the Malwa plateau. It may, however, be divided internally into two sections, the plateau section, locally called Malwi land, and the hilly tract called Dungri. The eastern part comprising the plateau division is in general an open and level plain sloping gently northward and highly cultivated, while the western portion of the State is wild and hilly.

As the State lies on the Malwa plateau, its climate is mild and equable. Though the diurnal range of the thermometer is considerable, the mean temperature during the year is comparatively low. In the hot season, moreover, the nights are invariably cool and refreshing.

The average rainfall for the last ten years was 28 inches as recorded at the capital, the highest 39.52 inches fell in 1910, the lowest 17.75 inches in 1904. The normal rainfall in the previous decade was 34 inches. Since the great famine of 1899-1900, when the fall was only 14.5 inches, the average has been considerably lower.

III. *Density*.—The mean density of population for the whole State gives 117 persons to the square mile against 123 in 1901. Considering that a great part of the State is hilly producing only inferior crops, the density compares favourably with that of the sister

States of Sailana (96) and Jhabua (83) which are similarly situated. In the whole of the Malwa Political Charge, however, Ratlam stands last but one in point of density. If the town of Ratlam is excluded

the density is reduced to 73 persons, shewing the effect of the hilly tract.

IV. *Towns and Villages*.—For Census purposes a Town was held to be a locality having a population of 5,000 or more ; and such other places of less than 5,000 inhabitants as might be considered to have distinct urban characteristics or historic associations were also treated as towns. There is only one town, *viz.*, Ratlam, answering the above qualifications. The population of this place at the successive censuses has been (1881) 31,066, (1891) 29,822, (1901) 36,321 and (1911) 27,957. Ratlam was once the chief centre of trade in opium, tobacco, salt, piece-goods, etc., in Malwa ; but the opening of the Godhra-Nagda-Muttra Railway dealt a blow to the mart by diverting the trade to other channels and by opening fresh distributing centres in the neighbourhood. Moreover, the city was visited seven times by plague during the last decade. These causes have reduced the urban population 23 per cent. since 1901. The rural population has, however, increased 12 per cent. in the last decade.

A village for Census purposes was held to be a revenue village with attendant hamlets. Thus a census village was merely a revenue unit, *i. e.*, any area separately assessed to land revenue. The total number of occupied villages in the whole State was 224 against 196 returned in 1901, 210 in 1891 and 154 in 1881. The rise of 28 villages in the last decade is due partly to deserted villages in the famine of 1900 having been repopulated, the State having offered every facility to cultivators to recoup their resources, and partly to the escheat of the jagir of Kelkatch with its 13 attendant hamlets (*paras*) to Khalsa and their inclusion in the Bajna Tahsil. Unlike in the Ratlam Tahsil and the Jagir Pargana, where *paras* are included in parent villages, each hamlet (*para*) in the Bajna Tahsil has always been considered a separate revenue village.

The number of deserted villages at this census was 24 against 28 in 1901. These villages, though uninhabited, yield land revenue.

As usual, villages of "under 500" population predominate, 200 coming under this class, 19 under "500—1 000," 4 under "1000—2000," and 1 under "2000—5000." The average village population is 211, about 56 per cent. of the rural population living in villages of "under 500" class.

V. *Houses and Families.*—The total number of occupied houses in the State was 19,083 against 16,688 in 1901. No comparison with the figures of the previous Census is possible in dealing with the houses owing to the alteration in the definition of a *house* adopted on the present occasion, which was :—

- (i) The dwelling place of one or more families with their dependants and resident servants having an independent entrance, whether that entrance be from a road, gallery, balcony, corridor, court-yard or otherwise,
- (ii) any structure other than a dwelling house such as tent, pavilion, temple, *sarai*, etc., or a site, camping ground, *ghat*, etc., to which a separate number has been affixed.

A Census house on this occasion was, therefore, *virtually* a building inhabited by *one or more families*, that is by people living together and having *one common chulah* (fire place), and this is solely responsible for the apparent increase in the number of houses at this census.

The average number of persons per house was 4 in 1911 as in 1901, that of houses per square mile being 30 and 26 respectively.

VI. *Population and Variations.*—The population of the State, excluding the villages held by Sarwan and Shivgarh, at successive Censuses has been :—

An increase of 2 per cent. took place in the first decade. Since then the population has been on the decline, principally owing to the famine of 1900, the opening up of the country and visitations of plague. These causes of variation affected the urban population which has decreased considerably.

But the rural population has increased by about 12 per cent. The population in the hilly tract (including the Jagirs of Sarwan and Shivgarh) has increased 50 per cent., that in the Tahsil of Bajna alone increasing 97 per cent. This great increase is mostly due to the migration of Bhils from the neighbouring States and partly to the fact that Bhils enjoy immunity from plague owing to their living in the interior and their huts being sparsely situated, and also to the good seasons which have followed the previous enumeration, which had been carried out immediately after the great famine which had told so heavily on the Bhils.

VII. *Movement of Population.*—Of the total population 51,187 persons or 68 per cent. were born within the State, leaving 32 per cent. for immigrants. Of these about 23 per cent. were sent by other States of Central India, *viz.*, Gwalior 9 per cent., Jaora 4, Indore 3, Dhar 2, others sending in smaller numbers. Of the Provinces and States beyond the Agency, the Rajputana States of Banswara, Partabgarh, Dungarpur and Kushalgarh sent about 7 per cent., Bombay and the United Provinces one per cent. each.

Migration between Ratlam and the neighbouring Central India States is mainly due to the fact that females born in one town are often married into another and their generally going to their parents' home for their first confinement and partly to business visits by males.

The immigration from the neighbouring Rajputana States accounts partly for the enormous rise in the Bhil population in the Bajna Tahsil.

VIII. *Religion.*—The inset table shows the general distribution of the population by religion, proportional figures and variations. Of the total popula-

tion 61 per cent. are Hindus, 6 per cent. Jains, 20 Animists, and 18 Musalmans. Christians number 384, Parsis 60, Jews 7 and others 7 (Arya 6 and Sikh 1). Compared with the religious distribution of the previous census all except the Animists have declined. The comparatively large number of Christians in the Ratlam State is due to the railway colony and the presence of the Canadian Presbyterian Mission at the capital.

IX. *Age, Sex and Civil Condition.*—Table VII gives in 19 age-periods the number of males and females at each age-period. Males and females at periods 5-10, 20-25, 25-30, 30-35 shew large numbers. There are 978 wives to 1,000 husbands among Hindus, 981 among Jains, 978 among Musalmans, and 1,060 among Animists, the increase in the last is due to the custom of keeping more than one wife or a widow living with a man without going through a form of marriage.

The couvade custom, it is generally believed, existed formerly among Bargundas. But on being questioned about this belief, they explain it away by saying that the story originated in the incident of a Bargunda's evading the service of a subpoena by pretending that according to the custom among his caste he had to take to his bed for some days as his wife had given birth to a child.

Among local Thoris and Kuchbandas and among Bharatpuri, Chamars, Kolis, Minas and Ahirs and among Mewatis (Musalmans) the younger brother has a prior claim (*devar-batta*,) to the hand of his elder brother's widow, and if she marries outside the family, money compensation has to be paid to the brothers by the new husband.

X. Education.—Of the total population 6,832 persons (6,027 males and 805 females), or 9 per cent. are literate.

The inset shows their religious distribution. Of the total number

of literates 687 persons (613 males and 74 females) know English also;—Hindus 352 males and 7 females ; Aryas 2 males ; Jains 85 males ; Musalmans 42 males and 1 female ; Christians 106 males and 64 females ; Parsis 24 males and 1 female ; Jews 2 males and 1 female.

The State maintains a High School at the capital with vernacular sections and 21 Primary schools. There are also 40 private elementary schools. All these 61 schools are attended by 2,323 boys. Of these, Brahmans number 324,

Rajputs 96, Banias 108, other Hindus 315; Jains 637; Musalmans 787 and Christians 56.

A monthly magazine, started in 1908 and called *Satyarth Patrika*, is published in English and Hindi every month, of which about 330 copies are circulated.

XI. Language.—The prevailing dialects are Malwi, Bhili, Hindustani, Gujarati and Marwari, being spoken by 69, 16, 5, 3 and 1 per cent. respectively. Malwi and its sub-division Rangri are spoken in the Malwa tract while Bhili and Gujarati are used by the aborigines inhabiting the Bajna Tahsil.

XII. Infirmities.—There were in all 146 persons (80 males and

66 females), afflicted with the four kinds of infirmities recorded, in the total population as shown in the inset. Of these, 38 persons (23 males and 15 females) were found in Ratlam City, viz., 1 male and 3 females insane ; 6 males and 1 female deaf-mute ; 15 males and 11 females blind and 1 male leper.

Of the total number of afflicted persons 98 (57 males and 41 females) were born in the State, 17 persons in Gwalior and 18 in other States of Central India, while 9 were sent by the Rajputana States, 2 by Punjab, 1 by the United Provinces and 1 by Kandahar.

Distributed by selected castes Bhils shewed 20 persons (12 males and 8 females) mostly blind and lepers, Banias 11 (6 males and 5 females), Rajputs 7 (3 males and 4 females), Pathans 6 (2 males and 4 females), Shaikhs 4 (2 males and 2 females) and Chamars 4 (2 males and 2 females).

XIII. *Caste, Tribe and Race.*—Among Hindus the predominating castes are Brahman (7 per cent.), Rajput (6 per cent.), Kunbi and Balai (4 per cent. each), Bania, Kumhar, (3 per cent. each), Chamar Dhakad, Jat, Teli, (2 per cent. each) and others below 2 per cent. each.

The Muhammadans are divided up into Shaikh, Pathan, Bohra, each forming 2 per cent. of the population of the State. Bhils form 3 per cent.

The genuine agricultural classes are Bhil, Dhakad, Gujar, Kachhi, Kunbi, Mali, Moghia, Nayak, but others such as Brahman, Bania, Rajput, Kumhar, Teli, Nai, also engage in this calling.

XIV. *Occupation.*—On this occasion occupations were classified on the simple and more scientific system of M. Bertillon adapted to Indian conditions. Table XV gives in detail all the occupations returned which are distributed into 4 main classes. Agriculture heads the list supporting 50 per cent. of the population, Industry giving employment to 18 per cent., Commerce to 15 per cent., Profession to 5 per cent., miscellaneous occupations supporting 12 per cent. people.

Besides the four ginning factories worked by steam there are about 200 hand gin workers. Dyeing, tie-dyeing, metal work in brass and iron, native shoe-making, cotton-weaving and manufacture of ball opium are the usual hand industries to be found in Ratlam City, but they cannot be said to be in a thriving condition and they give employment to only a small number of the local people.

XV. *Special Schedule.*—At the present census, as in 1901, the Darbar took the opportunity of collecting additional information regarding agricultural stock, wells, temples, mosques, &c., in a separate schedule of 8 columns printed at Ratlam. Care was taken to ensure accuracy of returns, and the results, which appear to be more correct than on the former occasion, are given in Appendix IV.
