

The registered rates show a marked fall, which can unhesitatingly be attributed to the shortcomings of the new registration system. An illustration will suffice. The registered birth rate in the urban areas of Uttar Pradesh, where the old system continues, stands round 30 per mille, whereas in the rural areas, where the new system has been introduced, it is well below 15 per mille. The rural population in Uttar Pradesh forms 86% of the total and thus the overall registered birth rate for the whole State stands close to the rural rate, that is, at a little over 15 per mille. A closer study seems necessary to decide as to which areas may be taken to have maintained their pristine efficiency in registration, so that on the assumption of constancy in deficiency, it may be possible to draw some inferences from the trends in the registered rates. A start in the matter has been made by excluding certain States, which suffer from gross under-registration, when striking all-India figures. Registration in Assam and Bihar is particularly poor. Rajasthan does not have a registration system over half the State and in the other half, where it obtains, the system does not work satisfactorily. Hence, these three States have been excluded from the all-India figures shown in the various tables. Among the centrally administered areas, only Delhi has a system of registration of long standing and has been included in all-India figures. The data for other areas are, however, given for whatever they are worth. Tripura does not possess a system of registration, and the figures for Jammu and Kashmir have not been received. Neither of these States has, therefore, been shown in the tables. In accordance with the current practice, mid-year registration area population required for calculating rates have been obtained on the basis of the last intercensal annual increase rate.

In the end, I would like to thank the various State authorities, who supplied the basic data for this publication. I hope with their active co-operation, it will be possible to improve in future the quality and coverage of Indian vital statistics.
