
5. It is, therefore, requested that the application of eligible and willing officers/candidates and who can be spared immediately in the event of selection may be forwarded to "The Under Secretary, Admn.III Section, Office of Registrar General, India, Ministry of Home Affairs, 2-A Mansingh Road, New Delhi-110011" in duplicate in the prescribed proforma (Annexure-III) duly signed by the applicant and certified by the Controlling Officers within a period of 60 days from the date of issue/publishing of this circular in the "Rozgar Samachar/Employment News". Candidates who apply for the above post will not be allowed to withdraw their candidature subsequently.

6. Period of deputation (including short-term contract) including period of deputation(including short-term contract) in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization/department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three (3) years.

7. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation(including short-term contract) shall not be exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications).
