
# Background

- Before each census, the Census Directorates are required to provide maps of rural and urban frame to ensure complete coverage
- In many cases latest maps of towns and their wards were not available in earlier Censuses
- As a result, there had been instances of overlapping and omissions of areas, especially in urban areas

- Many of the maps were found to be old. Not representing the ground reality today
- Extent and boundary of towns changed
- Number of Wards changed in many cases
- For 2011 Census, maps need to be updated.

## Focus on....

- Using maps in pre-census planning in urban areas
- Aimed to ensure complete coverage in 2011 Census
- No omission or over-lapping
- Possible by preparing maps showing complete details for each ward before census
- Details: (House number, Purpose of use, Number of Floors, Population)

## Main objectives

1. To prepare separate ward maps in digital format showing lanes, sub-lanes, houses with number and important land marks.
2. To demarcate geo-referenced Census Enumeration Blocks for use in 2011 Census in case of Capital Cities (33).
3. To achieve the objective of preparing ward maps in digital format support of Survey of India (SOI) is taken in a substantive manner.

# Requirements

- To obtain town maps showing ward boundaries and their numbers as per the latest notification.
- Individual separate detailed map of wards up to each lane and sub lane showing layout of buildings, house with their number in hard and soft copy.
- This is initially required for capital cities/ towns first.

# Step involved

Step 1: Collecting town maps from Municipal Corporation

Step 2: To update town maps (Capital city)

- Extension in urban limits
- Change in number of wards
- Extension in urban build up area


Step 3: Finalization of hard copy maps

- Final drawing
- Certification from the Municipal Corporations



#### Step 4: Conversion into vector format

- Scanning
- Raster to vector
- Digitization

Step 5: Preparation of separate ward maps with the help of certified town maps

Step 6: SOI Shall provide geo-referenced satellite image based map of wards for field survey showing each building, house, lane, by-lane, etc.



## Step 7: Field verification and survey

- Surrounding ward numbers
- Marking roads, lanes, sub-lanes, layout of housing structures & house numbers
  - Using Corporation maps
  - Other sources (e.g., Town guide maps, Arial photographs, Satellite imageries, etc.)
- Physical landmarks and other important places
- House numbering and collection of information.

## Step 8: Finalization of Ward-wise hard copy maps


- Final drawing
- Preparation of data sheet

## Step 9: ORGI will hand over to SOI for updating digital database

- Final drawing
- Attribute data

## Step 10: SOI will link attribute data with digital database of wards

# Updated Map




Step 11: Digitization & finalization of Ward maps by SOI

Step 12: Carving out EBs and Supervisory Circles in each ward

- Census Enumeration Blocks on the basis of population or approximate number of households or number of houses
- Supervisory Circles (6 - 8 CEBs) on the basis of permanent boundaries, if possible

Step 13: Printing of following maps for use in Houselisting Operations in 2010

- Ward map
- Census Enumeration Block Map



## Step 13: Handing over to local authorities for use in Houselisting

- Ward map
- Supervisory circle or Locator Map
- Census Enumeration Block Map

## Step 14: Updating as per houselisting information

- Ward map
- Census Enumeration Block Map

## Strategy ....

- DCOs have been advised to
  - Contact all Municipal Corp and Municipalities, etc.
  - Collect latest town maps
  - Also to collect Ward maps showing full details
  - Discuss the methodology of field verification
  - Consent on deploying municipal officials
  - Joint verification by DCO & MC officials
  - Also ex-DCO and ex- NSSO officials to be engaged

## Fund Requirement:

- Honorarium (Rs 2500) plus TA/DA as per Rules will be paid to the DCO officials and Municipality Officials
- Temporary Investigators : Rs 350 per day maximum 100 days
- 70 houses to be covered each day
- Drawing of the area showing houses to be submitted.
