G.S.R.....—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of Deputy Registrar General (Map) Group 'A' Post Recruitment Rules, 2010, the Office of the Registrar General, India, Assistant Registrar General (Map) Group 'A' Post Recruitment Rules, 2011, the Office of the Registrar General, India, Map Officer (Map) Group 'A' Post Recruitment Rules, 2001, the Office of the Registrar General, India, Research Officer (Map) Recruitment Rules, 2001, the Office of the Registrar General, India and the Offices of the Directorates of Census Operations in the States and Union Territories, Research Officer (Drawing) Recruitment Rules, 2011, the Office of the Registrar General, India, Map Analyst Group 'B (Gazetted)' Post Recruitment Rules, 2004, the Office of the Registrar General, India, Senior Geographer Group 'B' Post, Recruitment Rules, 2011, the Office of the Registrar General, India and the Offices of the Directorates of Census Operations in the States and Union Territories, Geographer, Group 'B' Post, Recruitment Rules, 2011, the Office of the Registrar General, India and the Offices of the Directorates of Census Operations in the States and Union Territories, Senior Drawing Assistant Group 'B' Post, Recruitment Rules, 2000, and the Office of the Registrar General, India and the Offices of the Directorates of Census Operations in the States and Union Territories, Sr. Draughtsman Group 'B' Post, Recruitment Rules, 2001, except as respect to things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Deputy Registrar General (Map), Assistant Registrar General (Map), Senior Research Officer (Map), Research Officer (Map), Research Officer (Drawing), Assistant Research Officer (Map), Map Analyst, Senior Drawing Assistant and Drawing Assistant in the Office of the Registrar General, India and in the Offices of the Directorate of Census Operations in States and Union Territories, under the Ministry of Home Affairs, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement- (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Home Affairs, Office of the Registrar General, India (Map Cadre posts) Recruitment Rules, 2024. (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of posts, classification, Level in the PayMatrix - The number of posts, their classification, PayLevel in the PayMatrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit, educational qualifications, etc.-The method of recruitment, age limit, educational qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.

4. Disqualification- No person,
(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person, having a spouse living; or
(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax-Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, and for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation of

Union Public Service Commission relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving-Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
